Keeping your pet cool in the heat

The sun is out and the heat is here. Hot temperatures can be lethal for your furry, feathered and exotic critters. These tips to help your pets stay cool this hot summer.

☹️ **Don'ts**

- ☹️ **Don't leave your pet in a parked car, even for a few minutes.**
Cars heat up rapidly, making the inside MUCH hotter than the outside temperature. Leaving the window open a few inches does not make the car cooler inside.
- ☹️ **Don't forget to leave fresh water for your pet.**
Leave several bowls of water in the house so your pet will be sure to get plenty of it.
- ☹️ **Don't tether your pet outside.**
Even if you think shade will protect your pet, the sun may shift, exposing the pet to direct sunlight and before you realize it.
- ☹️ **Don't ignore signs of heat stroke.**
Signs of heatstroke include panting rapidly, having trouble breathing, increased heart rate, walking strange

(almost disoriented) and the gums will be redder than normal. If you notice any of these symptoms, wrap your pet in a cool, wet towel, and get it to your veterinarian as quickly as possible.



😊 **Do's**

How to provide a cool and comfy summer living space

- 😊 **Do cool down your house as much as possible before you leave for work.**
- 😊 **Do cover the windows** and leave the air conditioning on "low," if you can. If you don't have air conditioning, place fans in the windows and run them on "exhaust" to circulate the air without sucking in the hot air from outside.
- 😊 **Do put small plastic containers filled with water in the freezer**

overnight.

During the day, place these containers (now filled with blocks of ice) around your pets' favorite sleeping spot.

😊 **Do allow your pet access to your basement, if possible.**

This could particularly benefit older pets, which may not be as mobile, or able to locate a cool spot for themselves.

Most important, if you suspect your pet is suffering from heat exposures, contact us as soon as possible.
